Mmapula Ikaneng started her career in the retirement fund industry in 1996 when she was serving as a trustee of Gauteng Building Industry Provident Fund and a CAWU Provident Fund. She was then appointed the Principal Officer of the Construction Industries Retirement Benefit Fund in May 2002. By that time she was employed as a research officer in the Production Pillar (Department) of the National Union of Mineworkers.
